

Checklist for Bedbug Treatment

In order to eliminate the bedbug infestation
you must comply with the following:

Make sure your home/apartment is thoroughly cleaned with all belongings picked up off of floor. Floors must be thoroughly vacuumed and bag/canister immediately discarded outside.

- All items must be removed from under bed.
- All bedding must be removed and placed in a tightly tied trash bag.
- All dressers and closets must be emptied into tightly tied trash bags and placed in an area of the house/apartment that is not going to be treated (such as the kitchen).
- *If you have an active infestation you must take all bedding and clothes to the Laundromat and dry on high heat for a minimum of 15 minutes. (It is recommended that this is done at the time of treatment so belongings are not reinfested or harboring bedbugs.) All bags that your belongings were in must be discarded and belongings must go into unused bags or laundry baskets to return back to your home/apartment.*
- All wall hangings must be removed.
- All people and pets must be out of the home/apartment for a minimum of 2 hours after completion of treatment. If you have a fish tank, it must be completely covered (airtight) and the air system must be turned off!
- All pets must remain out of the unit for the duration of time as well.
